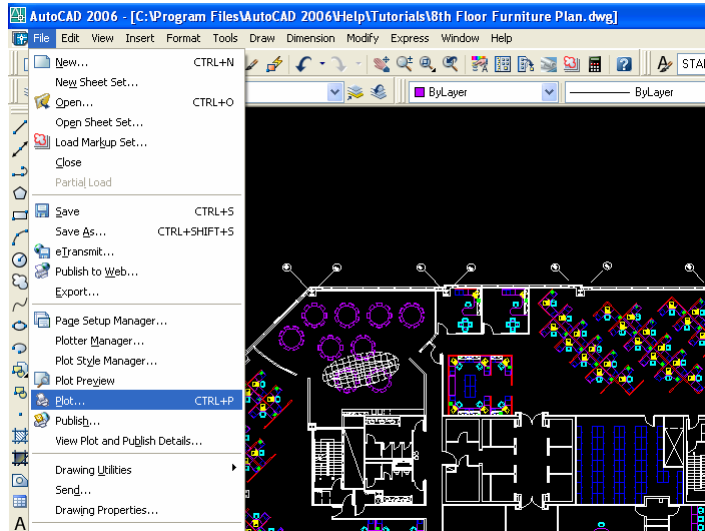
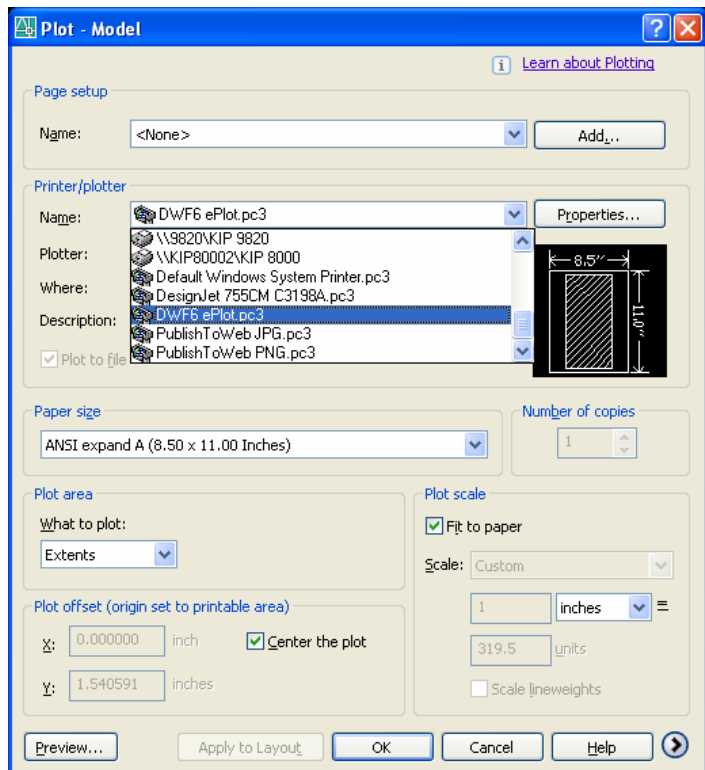


To create a DWF file in AutoCAD:

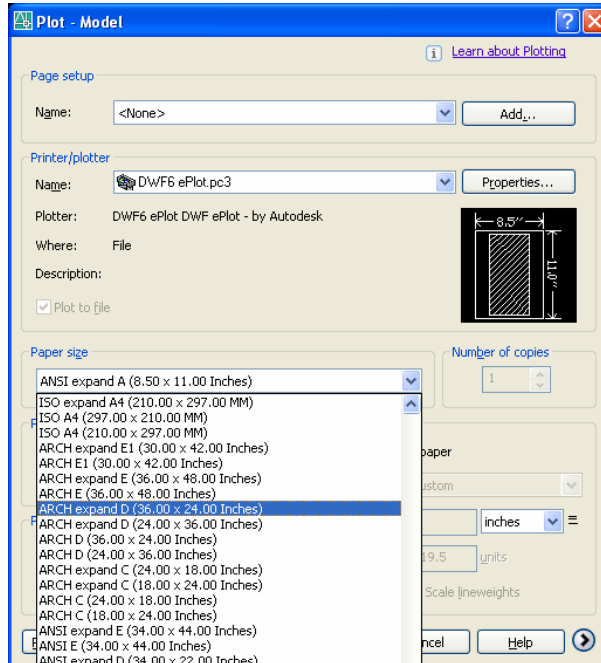
First open the DWG file in AutoCAD and click “file” on the upper menu bar, then select “Plot”.



1<sup>st</sup> select DWF printer

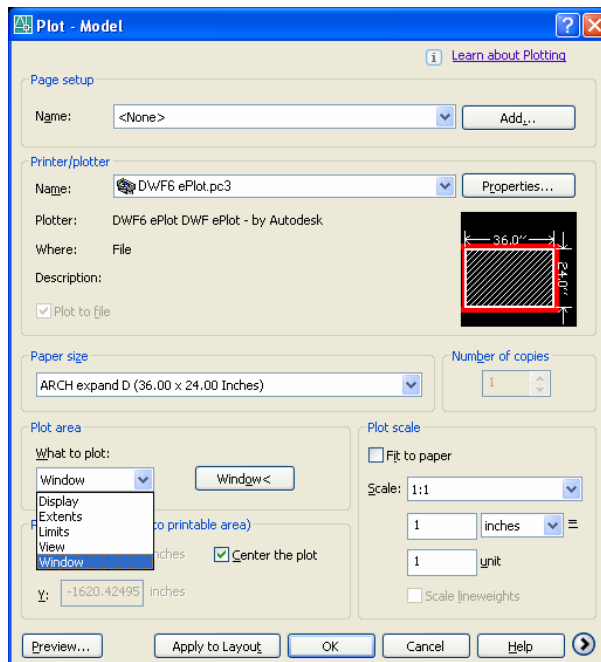


Select the appropriate sheet size.

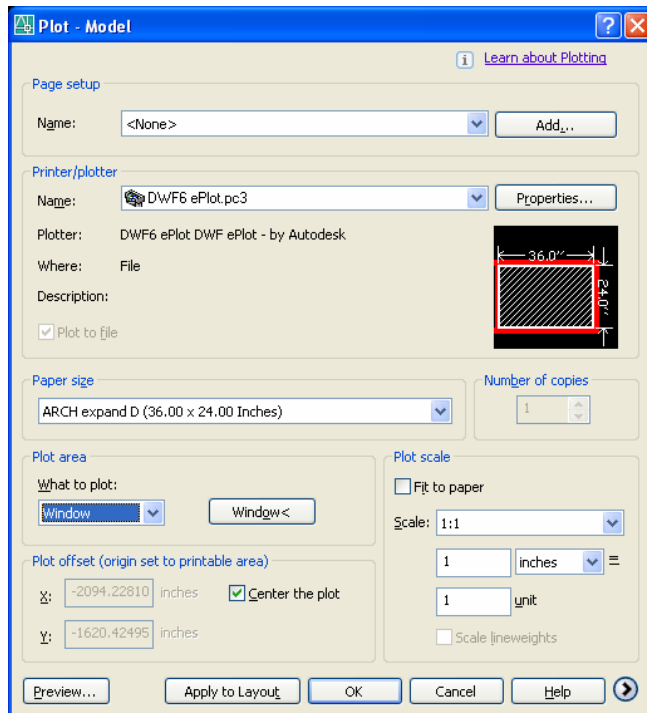


Next define the printable area around your file.

Also, select the appropriate scale and drawing units within the “plot scale” box, in lower right side of plot panel.

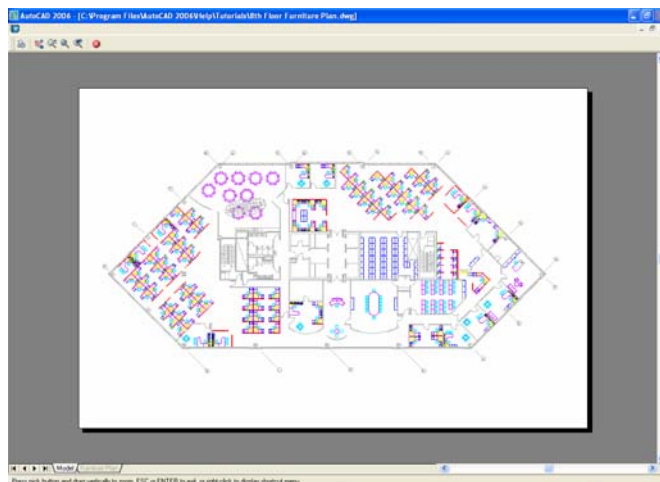


Use the preview button in lower left corner, to view you file.



Within the preview check to see if anything is cutoff, or too big, orientation is correct, etc.

Hit “Esc” on the keyboard to go back to the plot panel.

Scale is set

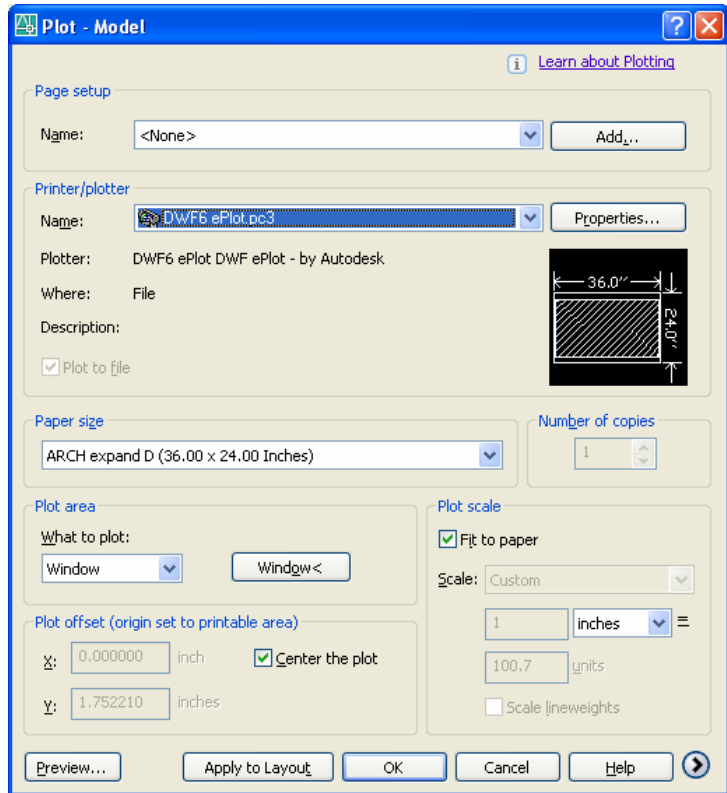
Paper size is set

Plot area is defined

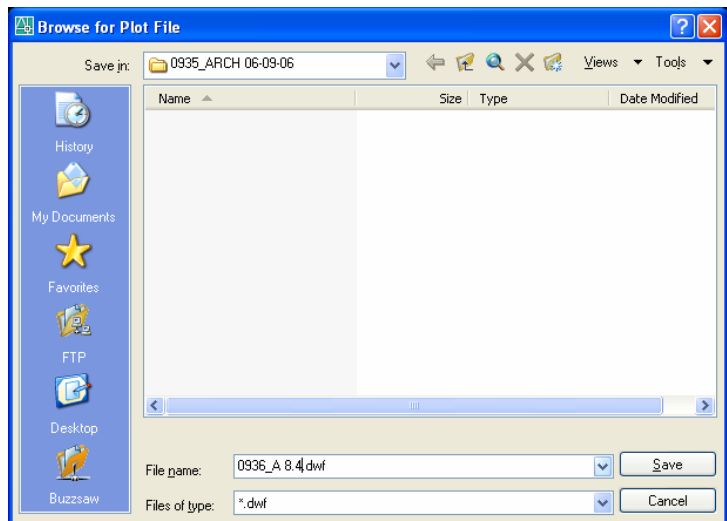
Preview was good
