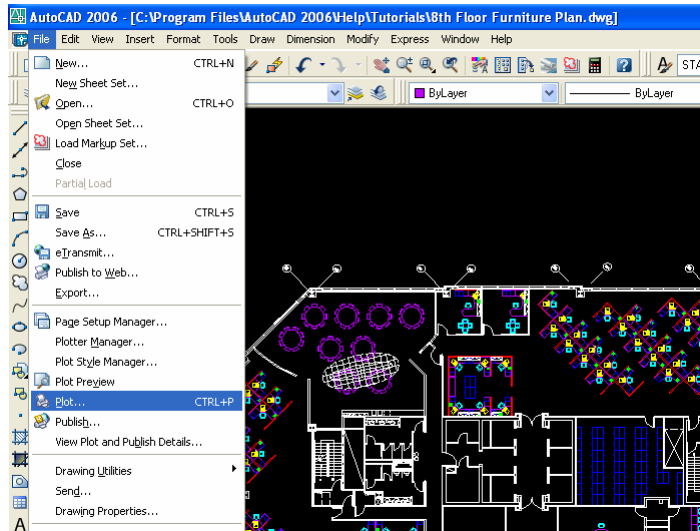


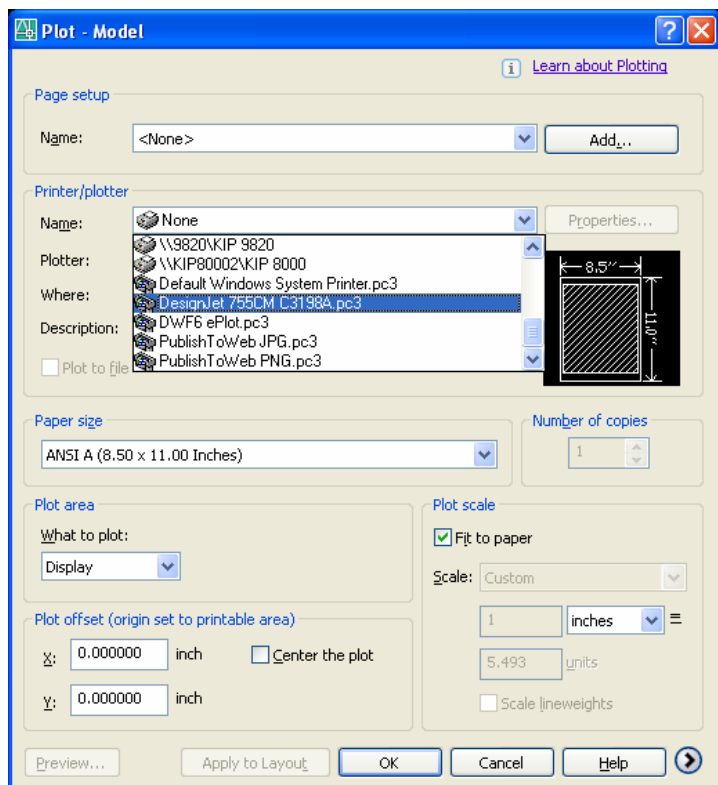
To create a PLT file
for an HP plotter:

In AutoCAD, click
on file on upper
menu bar, then
select plot.

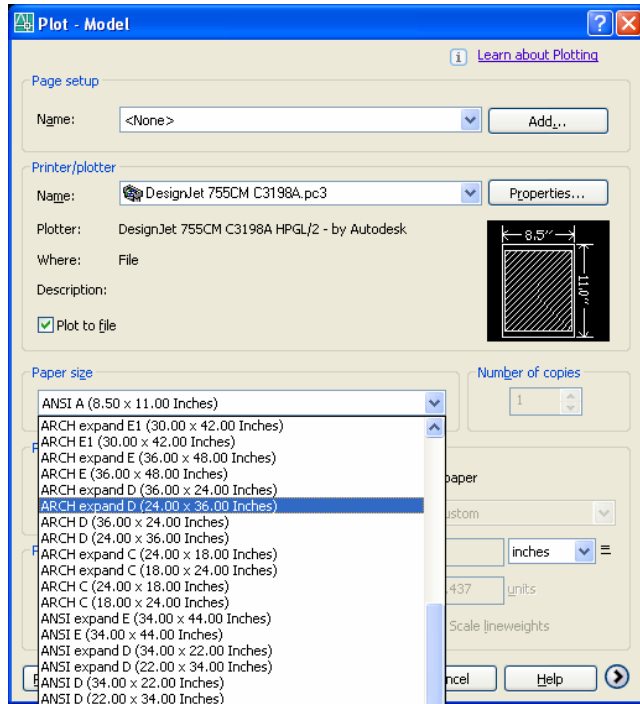


Select the DesignJet
755CM plotter

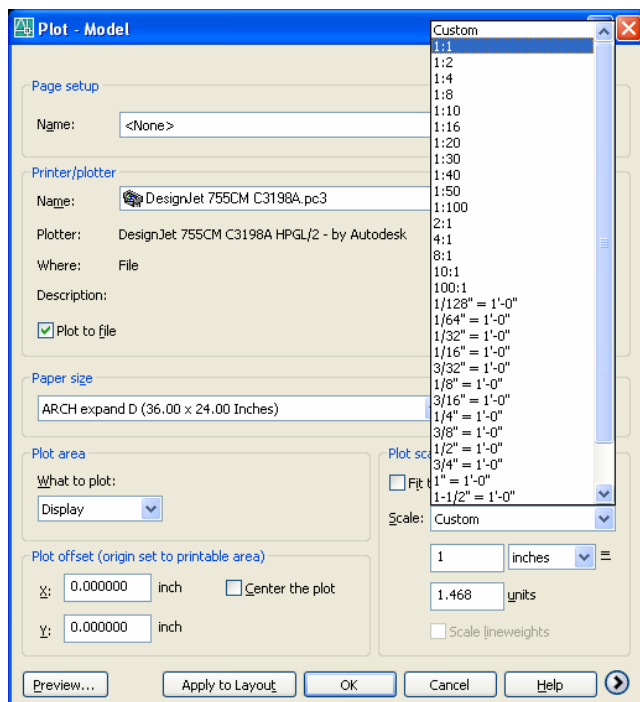

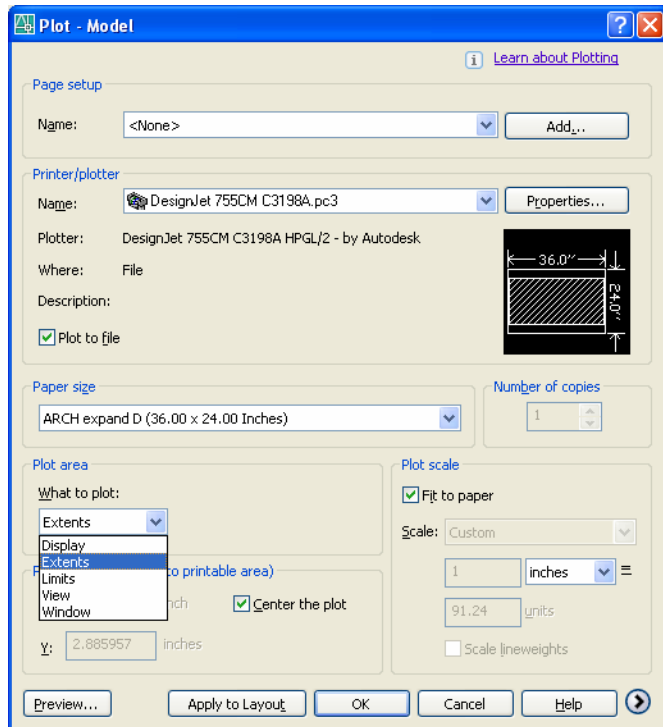
Select to appropriate sheet size for your PLT file.



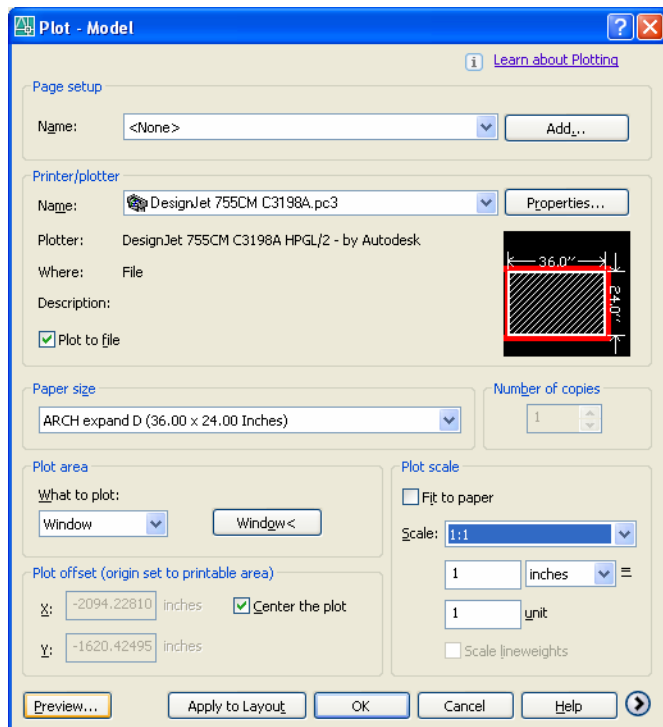
Then choose the corresponding scale you want your file to be printed in.



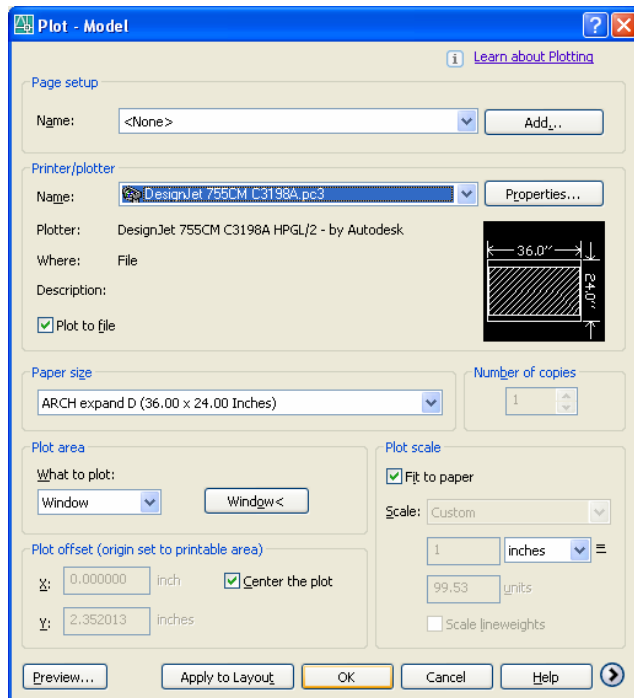
Define to PLT file printable area, by using the Plot area dropdown menu.



Select to scale of your file using the “plot scale” panel, in right lower corner of plot screen.



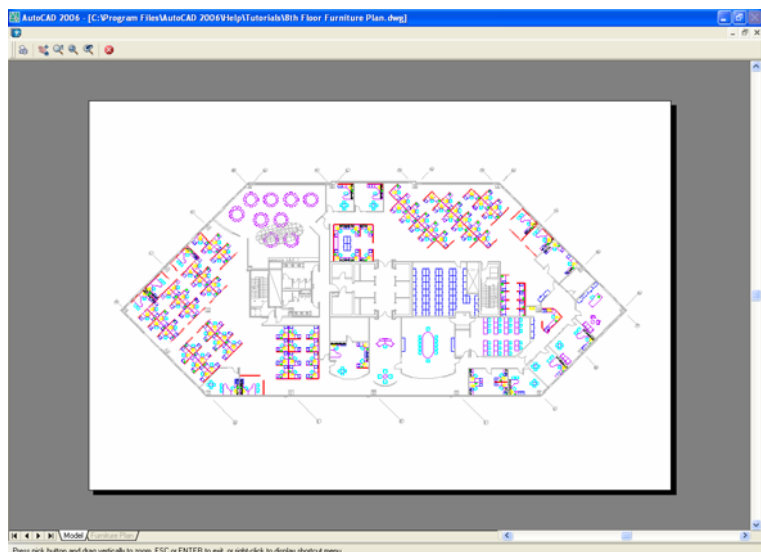
Use the Preview button to view the file, this button is in lower left corner of plot screen.



In preview screen make sure file is not cut off, rotated incorrectly, too small to see, all required images are present and viewable, etc.

Note this will be the last opportunity to view the file before creating a PLT file.

You can't view PLT files.

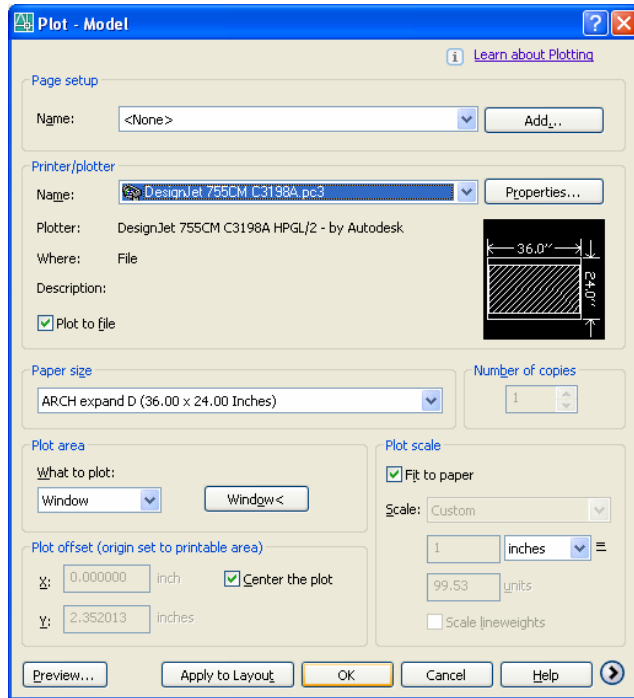

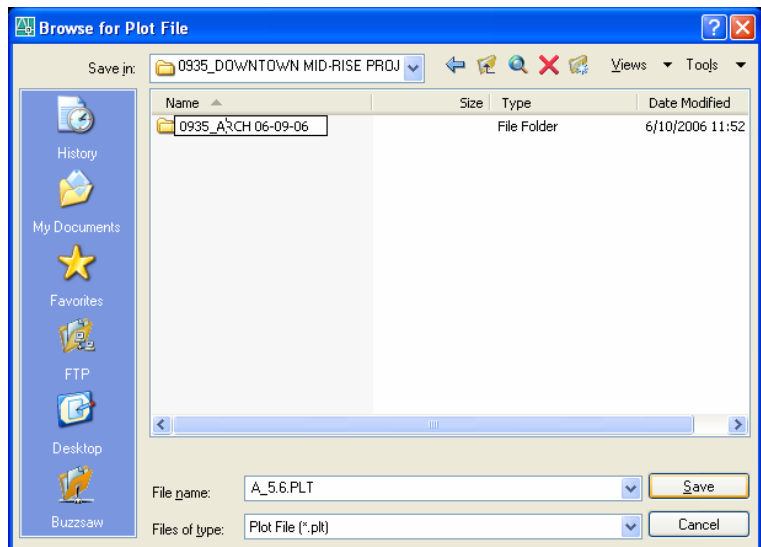
